


- Q. I want to have a garage sale (aka yard sale), do I need a permit?
- A. No permit is required for residents for up to two garage sales a year (no longer than 72 hours each) in unincorporated Palm Beach County.

- A. Call our Search Services section at 561-233-5001 or scan QR Code for information on how to conduct a search. It's a smart way to protect yourself.






- Q. The Planning, Zoning and Building Department is such a large department. Is there a general information number that I can call for assistance?




