

Liquor License Requirements Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Special Events

The following information provides the steps for obtaining a temporary liquor license. It is mandatory for events in Palm Beach County parks to possess this license if selling alcoholic beverages of any kind. Failure to produce a valid liquor license at your event to law enforcement will place the event in jeopardy of being canceled.

This is a lengthy process and must be completed and submitted to Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Special Events 21 days prior to your event date.

Term of license: 1-2 days (2 days is maximum)	
How to apply:	Obtain a letter from the Special Events Section confirming the permit is in process.
